4. Only the completed relevant information must be submitted as per Part 17 Section 95 of Regulation No 92 “Registration of existing dams” and Regulation No 94 “Registration of existing dams with safety risk”.

- The applicant must please furnish all the information requested, complete all items and indicate where the information is not relevant or unavailable.
- If not the registered owner of property, written proof of an agreement, lease, cession or other document to show authority to act, must be submitted.
- If a company or closed corporation or any other business operation, please supply company registration documents and particulars of the person authorised to make the application and submit a resolution to that effect.
- As per regulation 92 and 94 of the Water Resources Management Act 11 of 2013 a person who owns an existing dam or an existing dam with safety risk in Namibia must make an application for the registration of the dam to the Executive Director
